

# PARADE LINE UP FOR FLOATS AND VEHICLES DRIVING IN THE PARADE

Thank you for participating in the 2021 Woodbury Days Grande Parade.

The parade will be held on: **Sunday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> at 11:00 AM.**

All parade vehicles and floats must enter line-up on Woodlane Drive at Lake Road heading northbound only. Volunteers will direct you to the correct line-up area for your unit.



**This entrance is for floats and parade vehicles ONLY.** Parade participants looking to park or drop off people should **NOT** use this entrance.

## **Directions:**

### **COMING FROM THE NORTH**

Take I-494 South and exit on Lake Road (Exit 60). Turn right on Lake Rd. Turn left on Woodlane Dr.

### **COMING FROM THE SOUTH**

Take I-494 North and exit on Lake Road (Exit 60). Turn right on Lake Rd. Turn left on Woodlane Dr.

### **COMING FROM THE EAST**

Travel west on Lake Road toward Woodlane Dr. Turn right on Woodlane Dr.

## **PARADE RULES:**

- All PARADE UNITS must maintain a reasonable distance (typically no more than 2 car lengths) behind the UNIT in front of them. This applies to both floats/vehicles and walkers/performers.
- All PERFORMING UNITS must keep moving forward while performing to limit gaps in front of or behind your group.
- ALL HANDOUTS must be handed by walkers to parade spectators near the street curb and not thrown. Items cannot be distributed by riders in a vehicle or on a float. This includes but is not limited to stickers, water, frozen treats, and candy. This is a City Ordinance and must be followed.
- All RULES and REGULATIONS listed in the Grande Parade Application must also be adhered to.
